In Home Services

- **Homemaking**—laundry, sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, and meal preparation.
- **Personal Care**—trained personal care attendant for bathing, dressing, and grooming.
- **Respite Care**—trained caregivers stay with your loved one while you take care of you.
- **Home Chore**—small, basic home repairs and chores.
- **Foot Care**—in the privacy of your own home, or at the COA office.
- **Medication Set-up**—medication set-up by the COA nurse.

We also offer private duty nursing.

Support Services

- **Transportation**—transportation for non-emergent medical appointments.
- **Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program**—Certified Counselor on staff.
- **Information and Assistance on Senior Issues**—guiding you to resources available in Missaukee County and beyond.
- **Snow Removal Program**—snow removal financial assistance. Sign-up begins in October.
- **“Safe Senior” Address Signs and Senior Project Fresh**—two seasonal programs. Look for them in the summertime.

Where to Start

- **Call us**—Our office staff can get you started and will refer you to our Supervisor of Home Care Services (SHCS).
- **In-Home Visit**—The SHCS or our Staff Nurse will come to your house to assess your needs and establish a plan of care.
- **Client Services Provider**—You will be matched with a trained provider who will work directly with you to schedule and provide your care services.
- **On-going Care**—Periodically, our nurse or staff will call or visit to assure you are satisfactorily receiving your care according to plan.
